**After watching this episode, choose from the following questions and/or tasks to extend your learning**

- What happened in 1816? Explain how that affected the mission.
  - Name some unique things about this mission. What makes it different from other missions?
  - Why did the Native American Cupa peoples cry when moving to the mission in 1903?
  - Describe the game of Shinny.
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- What do you think it would be like to go to school at the mission?
  - Why do you think they call this area a “village”?
